

### **Summary of Operator's Rules for EuroJackpot Lottery**

EuroJackpot is a Lottery game in which players from various European countries join in the fun of a coordinated game to win huge life changing jackpots. You pick five numbers (from 1 to 50) and two 'Euro' numbers (from 1 to 10). Each draw, five random numbers (from the main 50 numbers) and two random 'Euro' numbers (from 1 to 10) are drawn.

The minimum jackpot is €10 million (approx. AUD \$17 million) and rolls up from there if the jackpot is not won. There is a jackpot cap of is €90 million (approx. AUD \$140 million).

Draws occur once per week on Friday night (Helsinki time).
