

Summary of Operator's Rules for UK National Lottery 'Lotto'

To play Lotto, simply select 6 numbers from 1 to 59 or choose a Quick Play. To win the jackpot, all 6 main numbers must be matched. If there's more than one jackpot winner, the prize will be shared equally between all the jackpot winners. The minimum jackpots are estimated at £2 million on Wednesdays and £4 million on Saturdays. Draws take place on Wednesday and Saturday evenings UK time.

Jackpot rollovers

The Jackpot can roll five times and if it is not won in the fifth Rollover (**Must be Won Draw**), it will be distributed to the remaining cash Prize categories in the following percentages where there are winners: Match 5 plus bonus Ball 3%, Match 5 6%, Match 4 17% and Match 3 74%. If there are no winners in any category then the Lottery Operator and the UK Gaming Commission will determine the rates to reset the percentages amounts actual winners.

No more than one prize for play in any one draw

The holder of a winning ticket can win only one prize category per single game in any one drawing but shall be paid the highest prize won.

Tax

Lottery winnings are not currently taxed in the UK.

Promotional Prizes

Some promotional prizes that may be offered by the Lottery Operator to ticket holders within the Lottery Operator's country are excluded from the prizes that can be won by The Lottery Office Players. The Divisional prizes listed above are the valid prizes offered by The Lottery Office.
